



Compute Ontario Awards Funding to Create DRI Training Resources

February 12, 2024

We're pleased to announce that six collaborative teams will receive funding support for projects to create new DRI training materials and resources. A total of \$254,000 has been allocated for these projects, which will enhance training in DRI skills for Ontario researchers and students. The projects were selected through a call for proposals, issued in September. Responses were selected based on alignment with related regional and national priorities, as well as other criteria including feasibility and impact.
